- * 52 Accredited and >80 Non-Accredited Museums
- * Themes: Art, History, Judaica, Archeology, Ethnography, Science, Nature

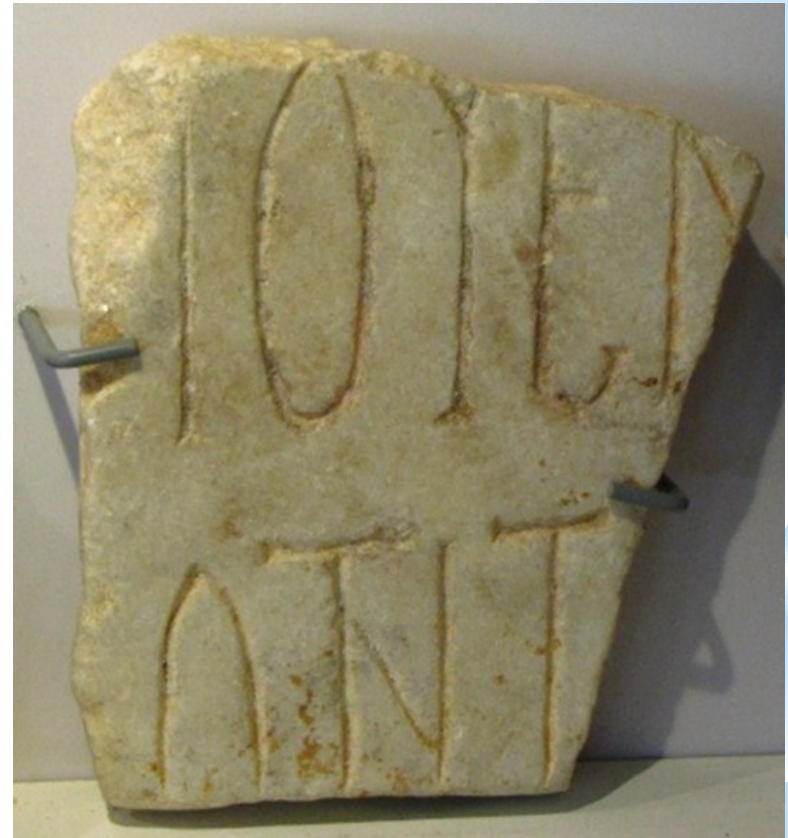

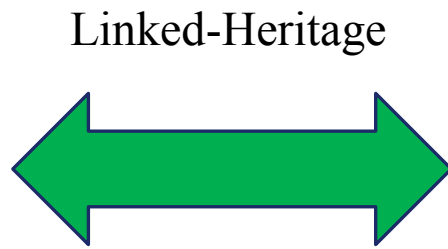

Description: A silver beaker, originally presented to the Public Hospital of the Judengassed in Frankfurt in 1717, by Hirsch Oppenheim, for Kiddush during the circumcision ceremony. The surface of the beaker is engraved with Hebrew inscriptions and the badges of the charity commissioners of Frankfurt from 1690-1769. Pair with C 1978.7.31.1

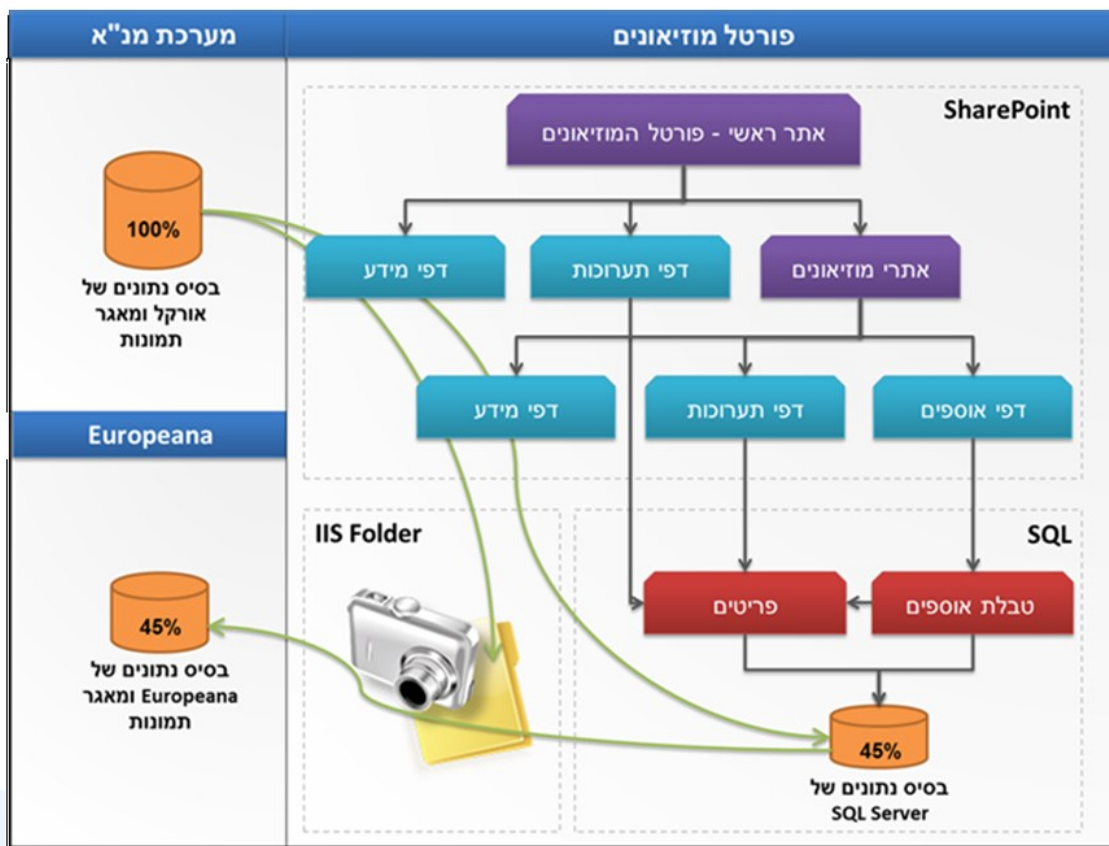

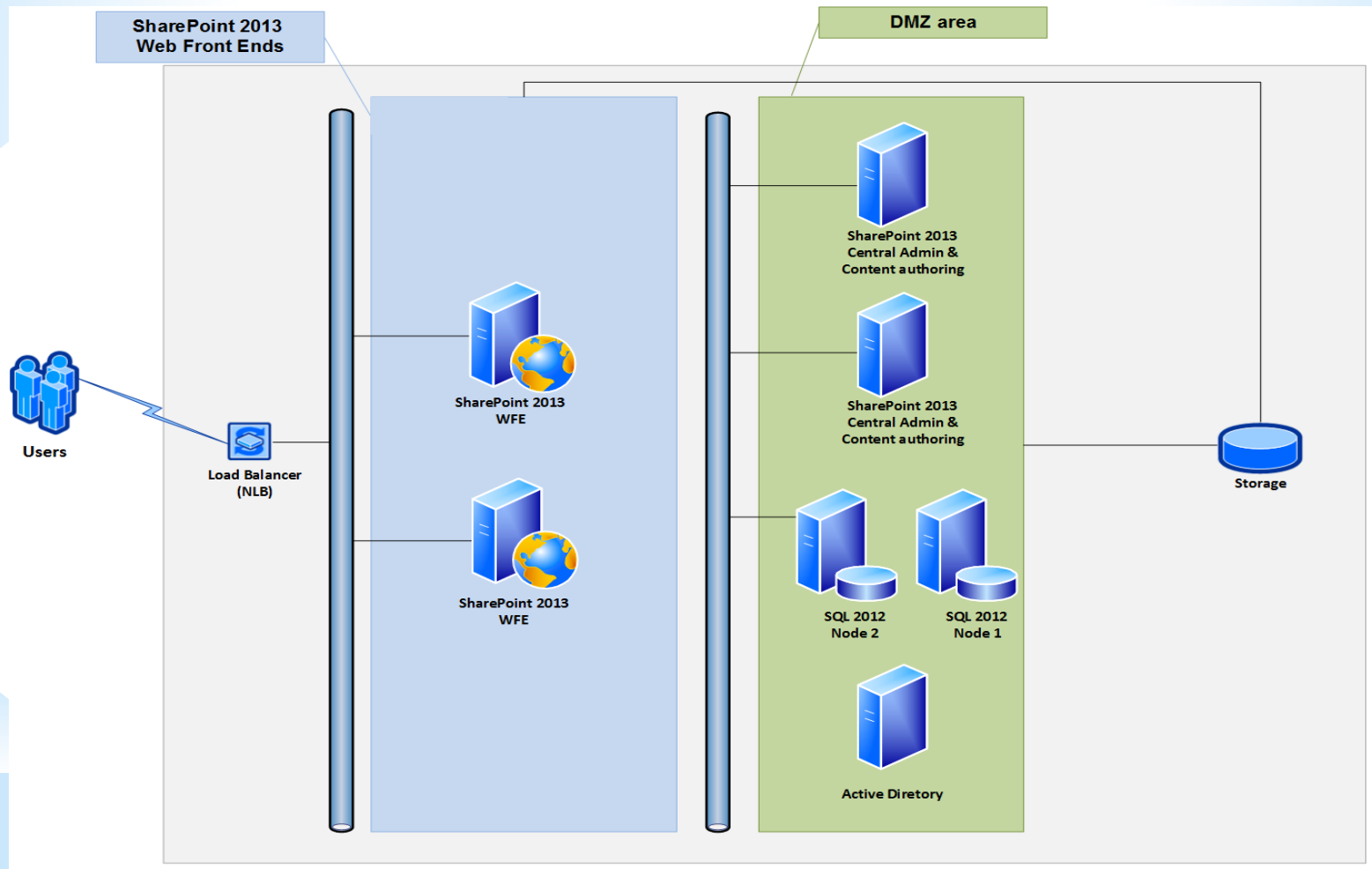

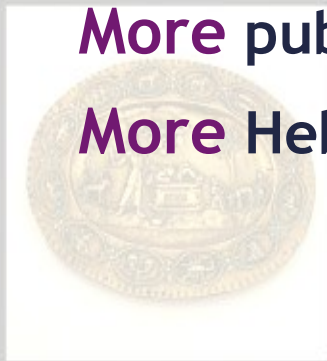
