FUNCTIONALITY OF HARMOSEARCH

The Harmonise service offers easy data exchange directly between databases, either via the automatic PULL service without any manual monitoring or via the PUSH service for in-between updates at the Harmonise portal – easy as sending emails.

Map your local data schema with a reference data model by using a comfortable mapping tool. This tool is made for data editors, who are not IT-experts, to easily connect with the Harmonise services. Find the data available in the Harmonise network by using your local query language. Harmonise maps your query, identifies the relevant providers and delivers the data you need. Extend the network with your own services for enhanced business benefits: Introduce data modification, content translation or market intelligence services to meet market needs.
