The gradual adoption of technological environments in the performing arts and the expanding of bandwidth have given rise to new forms of creative expression and space for experimentation and new business models for performing arts, reaching other spaces such as movie screens and cultural institutions with the distribution of high-definition content.

This workshop brings together tools and experiences of various cultural and academic institutions in Europe and presents the evolution of distributed environments, creative hubs and cultural broadcasting. The program has been developed considering the artists and technicians interested in co-creation, and may be of interest to teachers and programmers of cultural institutions.
