Lessons learned

- Collaboration between the Slovak Republic's Ministry of Culture and Ministry of Labour, Social Affairs and Family, with support of the **European Social Fund**
- The project operates with unemployed citizens who, together with the active participation of civic associations, restore selected state owned monuments
- Open to civil society organisations, foundations and municipalities in the Bratislava Region.

Positive effects:

- → Decreasing the unemployment rate in regions with low economic productivity
- → integrating the long-term unemployed into the heritage conservation sector, through connection with regional traditions and local citizens' cultural values
- → Creating more employment in the service sector
