Call for proposals - 2nd International Workshop on Artificial Intelligence for Historical Image and Visual Cultural Artefacts Enrichment

Austria</u>. The project aims to engage and test new technologies against the background of a selected dataset of food images for the benefit of accessing and analysing cultural data.
