<u>Europa Nostra</u> and its partner organisations working with youth in cultural heritage are launching a wide consultation on ?<u>Youth for the Future of Cultural Heritage in Europe</u>? as a contribution to the <u>European Year of Youth 2022</u>.

The consultation is developed in collaboration with the <u>European Students' Association for Cultural Heritage</u> (ESACH), the <u>Erasmus Student Network</u> (ESN), the <u>European Heritage Tribune</u> (EHT), <u>The Future is Heritage</u>, <u>Europeana Initiative Diversity & Inclusion Task Force</u>, <u>ICOMOS Emerging Professionals Working Group</u> and the <u>European Heritage Volunteers</u>.

The survey aims to:

- explore young people's visions on how cultural heritage should be integrated into key aspects of society: digital transformation, peacebuilding, sustainable development, tourism...
- find out the degree of satisfaction of young people regarding the way cultural heritage is addressed at European level;
- bring to light the main challenges young professionals, students, volunteers or enthusiasts are facing when interacting with and within the sector.

The responses will be gathered and result in a policy paper which seeks to trigger concrete actions to foster youth involvement in the cultural heritage sector and thus ensure a long-term legacy of the European Year of Youth 2022.
