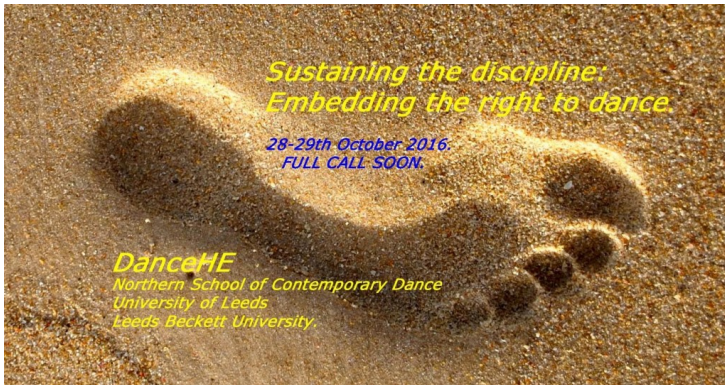


Dance Pilot and E-Space colleagues at DanceHE event "Sustaining the Discipline"

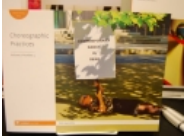
