Under the Slovenian Presidency of the Council it is announced the Europeana conference ?**Driving engagement ? participatory approaches to digital cultural heritage**' on 2 and 3 December.

We will delve into how cultural institutions are addressing the sustainability of digital participation; engaging communities with cultural heritage; crowdsourcing, citizen science, and enrichment; digital storytelling; and recommendations for audience participation and public engagement.
