

EUreka3D-XR presented at the 3D-4CH Winter School



EUreka3D initiative is invited in the Winter School organized by the 3D-4CH Competence Centre project, on 21 January, in Brussels and online: a keynote talk by project coordinator Antonella Fresa will present the openly accessible resources available to all CH professionals developed since 2023: the [EUreka3D Data Hub](#), a EU-based platform for safe storage, management and sharing of 3D assets, and the [Step to Success digitization guidelines](#) step-by-step derived from the EU VIGIE Study 2020/654. Additionally, the most recent developments of the project in the realm of XR tools will be shared, showcasing the [5 tools for XR creation](#) and the [3 demonstration scenarios in France, Spain and Cyprus](#).

The programme of the Winter School features a dynamic mix of keynote lectures, a comprehensive hands-on workshop, and collaborative sessions, tailored for museum professionals, digitisation experts, and cultural heritage practitioners at all levels of experience. The event is part of the **Twin it! Part II campaign** organized by the Europeana Foundation and the European Commission.
