

International Conference: Digital Presentation and Preservation of Cultural and Scientific Heritage - DiPP2020



The conference is organised under the patronage of Burgas Municipality and aims at presenting innovative results, research projects and applications in the field of digitisation, documentation, archiving, representation and preservation of global and national tangible and intangible cultural and scientific heritage. The **main focus** is to provide open access to

digitised cultural heritage and to set up sustainable policies for its continuous digital preservation and conservation. **Representatives of a number of public and specialised libraries, museums, galleries, archives, centres, both national and foreign research institutions and universities will be invited to participate and exchange experiences, ideas, knowledge and best practices of the field.**

There will be also Workshop on Open Access to Scientific Publications, Data and Data Science, which will primarily focus on the following activities: Open Access indicators, disseminate partners' best practices, discuss research problems in the field, discuss the possibilities of establishing a network of open access repositories, contribute to the problems of the harmonization of national legislation and practices and discuss the possibilities of developing training courses for creators and managers of scientific digital repositories to ensure interoperability.
