On the fourth day (25/10/2025), the Beyond Borders Hackathon took place in Lugano, organised by SECReTOUR in collaboration with [Europeana](#), [Photoconsortium International Association](#), the [UNESCO Chair of the Università della Svizzera Italiana in ICT to develop and promote sustainable tourism in World Heritage Sites](#) and the [UNESCO Chair of the University of Genoa in Anthropology of Health, Biosphere and Healing Systems](#), all members of the SECReTOUR Network of Common Interest. Two groups of students met with representatives of SECReTOUR partners and experts from USI to use the images taken from the europeana.eu platform to design new creative applications. In a few hours they were able to present to the appointed international Jury very interesting approaches, where physical and digital interactions have been proposed to promote cultural experiences in rural destinations.]
