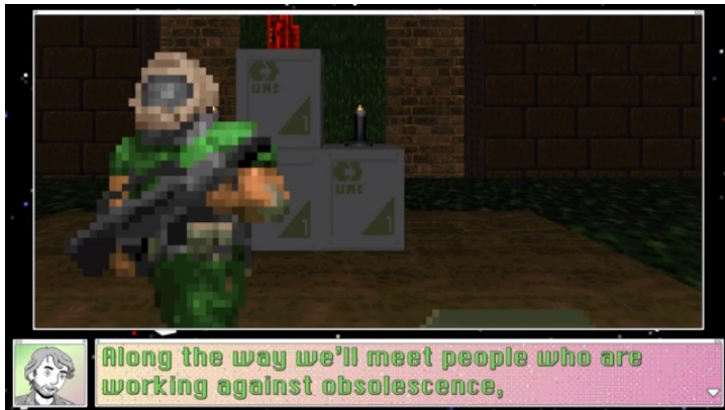


The abandoned spaces of the Internet
