

## Creation of controlled vocabulary for Art Nouveau content Proceeding

- **Analysing** partners' needs for consistent project terminology
- **Creating draft collections** of candidate terms being provided in mailing interaction
- **Evaluating partners' feedback**
- **Taking account of existing terminology tools**, such as the Getty Art and Architecture Thesaurus (AAT) in order **provide interoperability of metadata**
- **Including identifiers of relevant reference resources**, such as **GND and VIAF** (which encompasses the Identifiers of the Getty Union List of Artist Names) within the **authority file of PP Art Nouveau artists**


