Through the provision of such functionality, CULTURA will offer genuine user empowerment and unprecedented levels of engagement with digital cultural heritage collections.







The 1641 Depositions are a collection of XVII century manuscripts that comprise witness statements, examinations and associated materials related to a rebellion by the Catholic Irish in October 1641.

The Imaginum Patavinae Scientiae Archivum (IPSA) is a digital archive of illuminated manuscripts, both astrological and botanical codices, produced mainly in the Veneto region during the XIV and XV centuries.
