## What is it?

DIALLS is a European-funded project working with schools to understand and develop how young people make sense of Europe and its differing cultures. The project includes a Cultural Literacy Learning Programme (CLLP) to teach students how to communicate with each other and understand each other's perspectives, exploring the different cultural heritages and values of people who live in Europe. Classroom discussions are stimulated by specially licensed short wordless films, and the resources include lesson prompts for KS1, KS2 and KS3 in addition to professional development and assessment materials for teachers. These resources will become freely available online in Spring 2021.

## **Responding to challenging times**

The CLLP addresses important themes about learning to live together and being socially responsible; teaching children how to be tolerant, empathetic and inclusive in their engagement with each other. In these difficult times these skills and ideas are more important than ever.
