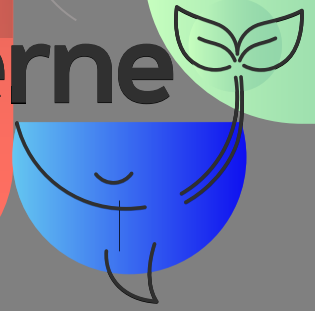

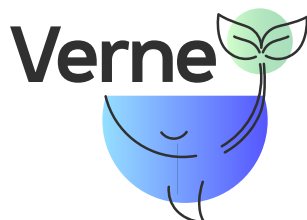
The event aims to foster practical exchange and peer learning, inspiring tourism destinations and practitioners to adopt and adapt existing good practices.
